- Work closely with JNU Passenger Services Manager, Juneau Cargo Services Manager, Pilots and Dispatch to ensure efficient movement of baggage, U.S. Mail and Freight
- Ground Service Vehicle/Equipment maintenance coordination
- Participate in bi-weekly outstation meetings and company manager meetings
- Ensure proper handling of US Mail, UPS and freight
- Maintain accurate data entry of Fuel Truck Fuel sheets
- Develop and implement processes for efficient movement of freight and mail
- Present a professional and positive image of Alaska Seaplanes
- Safely transport passengers to and from aircraft
